









LASAN Gas Tank Disposal Guide

Tanks are **NOT** accepted in any of LASAN's collection bins.



Gas tanks CAN EXPLODE in collection trucks and waste facilities and can hurt workers.

Here is a quick guide on where you should take different types of tanks for safe disposal:

Type of Tank	Size	Where to Dispose
 Butane  Helium  Propane	5 gal. or smaller 5 gal. or larger	LASAN SAFE Centers sanitation.lacity.gov/safecenters
 Carbon Dioxide  Freon  Oxygen	All	LA County Drop-off cleanla.lacounty.gov/hhw
Nitrous Oxide 	5 gal. or smaller 5 gal. or larger	LASAN SAFE Centers sanitation.lacity.gov/safecenters
Acetylene 	All	These items are not accepted at any drop-off site. Take this item back to the point of sale or contact the manufacturer for disposal information.
