Single-Use Carryout Bag Ban at Additional Businesses



BUSINESSES AFFECTED

- Food or Beverage Facilities
- Hardware Stores
- Apparel Stores
- Open Air Markets
- Farmers Markets

Under state law SB1053, certain retail establishments (like grocery stores, large retailers with a pharmacy, convenience stores, liquor stores, and food marts) may only offer or provide customers recycled paper carryout bags for a minimum charge of 10 cents.
