- Dispose of chemicals & pollutants responsibly

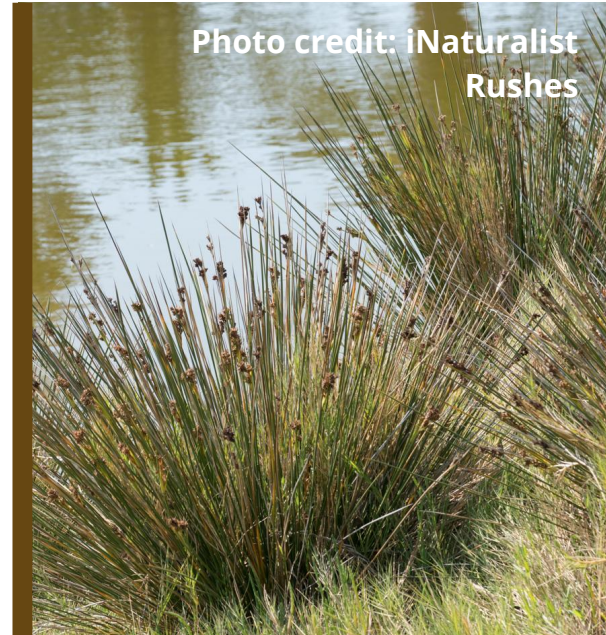
